

## COVID-19 OUTBREAK DASHBOARD

To protect the health of our St. Joan of Arc School Community and per the Emergency Order issued by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services on October 6, 2020, St. Joan of Arc School provides Public Notice to our School Community regarding *School Associated Cases* of COVID-19. Within 24 hours of being notified of a School Associated Case by our local Health Departments (Macomb, Wayne or Oakland counties) this dashboard will be updated to include new and cumulative COVID-19 case counts. Individuals identified as close contacts of *School Associated Cases* will be notified separately and directly by the local health department.

### STATUS OF INSTRUCTION AND SCHOOL-SPONSORED FUNCTIONS

- **Instruction:** Gr. 6-8 continues in Virtual learning until 11/17/2020. In-person learning will continue at this time for Preschool – Gr.5.
- **School-Sponsored Functions:** will remain unchanged at this time.

### SCHOOL ASSOCIATED COVID-19 CASES

On November 9, 2020, the Macomb County Health Department was provided notice of two new instances of *School Associated Cases* of COVID-19 amongst the St. Joan of Arc School Community. This data may include probable and confirmed cases as reported by the Macomb County Health Department among students, staff, administration, coaches, or visitors, if the person with COVID-19 was in the building during their infectious period.

We continue to disinfect frequently touched surface areas of the school. This includes spraying classrooms, hallways, and common areas, as needed, with a sanitizer, along with other methods of disinfection.

### ACTIONS YOU CAN TAKE

We recommend taking action to help limit the spread of COVID-19, even if staff or students are not experiencing symptoms:

- **Wear a mask** (covering mouth and nose) while in public or if people who do not live with you must visit your home.
- **Practice social distancing** (maintaining a distance of 6 feet apart).
- **Practice frequent handwashing** (using soap for 20 seconds or hand sanitizer with 60% alcohol).
- **Follow [capacity restrictions](#)** of social gatherings.
- **Cover coughs and sneezes** with a tissue or with the inside of your elbow and immediately wash your hands.
- **Stay home if you are sick;** you can also [get tested](#).
- **Answer the phone if the health department contacts you,** as a contact tracer may be trying to reach you with important information.

This information does not mean you should quarantine or isolate. Those members of the SJA School Community who were or are suspected to have been in close contact with a *School Associated Case* were notified by St. Joan of Arc School and/or the Macomb County Health Department.

Thank you for understanding that, due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the names of the individuals with COVID-19. We will continue to communicate changes and updates with you. With your participation, we believe we can maintain a safe environment while also providing quality education.
